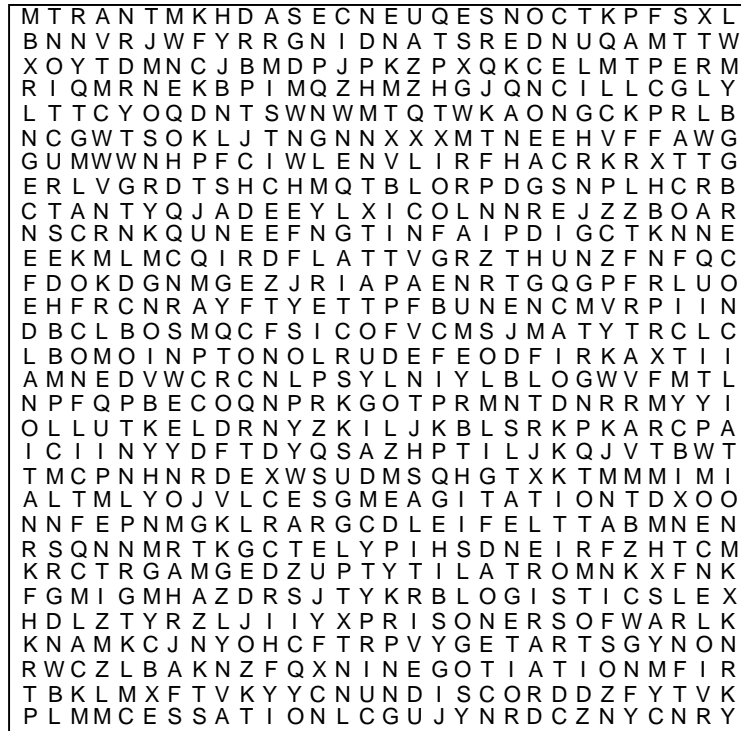
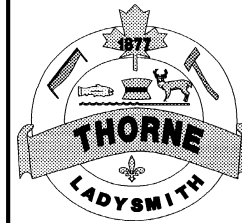

## MAPLE PUMPKIN CHEESECAKE

### Crust:

1 1/3 c graham cracker crumbs  
1/4 c. sugar  
5 T. butter, melted

### Filling:

3 (8 oz) packages cream cheese  
3 large eggs  
15 oz. can pure pumpkin puree  
14 oz. can sweetened condensed milk  
3 T Maple syrup  
2 tsp cinnamon  
1 tsp. nutmeg  
1/2 tsp salt

### Glaze:

1 c. heavy cream  
2/3 cup maple syrup  
3/4 cup pecan pieces

Combine crust ingredients and press into a 9-inch springform pan. Have filling ingredients at room temp. Beat the cream cheese on high until fluffy. Reduce speed and add eggs then increase speed to incorporate eggs. Add in the pumpkin, milk and maple syrup. Add spices and salt. Beat the mixture for awhile; this will make the cheesecake light and fluffy. Pour mixture into prepared crust, then tap the pan lightly on the work surface to remove any air pockets. Bake at 325° until the centre appears nearly set but jiggles a little when shaken - approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes. Cool for an hour then cover and chill at least 4 hours or overnight.

For the glaze, in a medium saucepan, combine the cream and maple syrup and bring to a boil. Boil until slightly thickened, about 25 minutes, stirring often. Stir in the pecan pieces. Cover and chill. To serve, stir then spoon glaze over cheesecake.

### A FEW HANDY HINTS

- Keep brown sugar soft by storing with a couple of marshmallows.
- Install a regular coat rack low down on the wall to store shoes safely off the floor.
