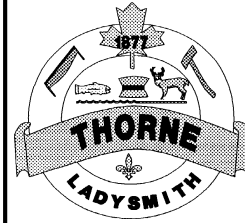

GREEN TOMATO RELISH

A 6-quart basket of green tomatoes
(don't peel them but do cut out the stem)

- 1 quart vinegar
- 2 1/2 lbs brown sugar
- 3 tsp. ground cloves
- 4 or 5 onions, sliced
- 3 tsp cinnamon
- 1 T. Pickling Salt

Into a large preserving kettle, put the tomatoes, cut into quarters or eighths. Pour in the vinegar and all the rest. Boil till the relish is thick enough to plop off the spoon. Don't boil too quickly - pull up a stool, sit there and stir fairly often - almost continuously towards the end when it becomes really thick and a bit spitty. Remember while you're doing it that you'll enjoy it all winter. Ladle into sterilized jars, it keeps for years.
